

CANON 1

Definitions

For the purpose of the Constitution and Canons of the Synod of the Diocese of Rupert's Land the following terms shall have the meaning given opposite each.

1. "administrator" - the person designated by Canon 4 as the administrator of the Diocese during the vacancy of the See or while the Bishop is unable to attend to diocesan duties.
2. "by-law" - an enactment setting forth in detail the rules to be observed in the practical carrying out of some Canon.
3. "Commissary" – an administrator, or a person holding a commission from the Bishop to perform duties designated in that commission or to act as the Bishop's representative.
4. "communicant" - “a member of the Anglican Church of Canada or a Church in full communion with the Anglican Church of Canada, who partakes of the Holy Communion.”
5. “constituency” – a Deanery, Archdeaconry, or any formal grouping of parishes.
6. "Rules of Order" - rules adopted for the government of the proceedings of a session of Synod.
7. “vestry” – may be called parish council.
