**T**hrough Grow Hope, you can become a “farmer” by sponsoring an acre of farmland. Funds raised through the project may be matched up to 4:1 through the Foodgrains Bank and will be used to support people around the world with emergency food and longer-term food security support.

While you provide hope to people around the world through food, you can also learn more about farming and what’s involved in growing food. During the growing season you will receive monthly field updates.

### HOW IT WORKS

A generous farmer donates land and grows a crop. It costs \$300 per acre for seed, fuel and other inputs.

At the end of the growing season, the farmer will sell the crop and donate the proceeds to the Foodgrains Bank. The money may then be matched by funds from the Canadian government.

**Your sponsorship grows and multiplies—just like the seeds planted by the farmer.**

### GET INVOLVED
