Dr. Karoline M. Lewis joined the faculty of Luther Seminary, St. Paul in 2007 and is the Alvin N. Rogness Associate Professor of Homiletics. She has taught at Augsburg College, Candler School of Theology, and Columbia Theological Seminary. Ordained in the Evangelical Lutheran Church in America, Lewis was Associate Pastor of Worship and Education at Amazing Grace Lutheran Church in Lawrenceville, Georgia. A graduate of Northwestern University, Lewis received the M.Div. degree from Luther Seminary and the Ph.D. degree in New Testament Studies from Emory University. She is the author of *Rereading the “Shepherd Discourse:” Restoring the Integrity of John 9:39-10:21* (Peter Lang Publishing, 2008), the introduction and study notes for the Gospel of John in the *Lutheran Study Bible* (Augsburg Fortress, 2009), co-author of *New Proclamation: Year B, 2009, Easter through Christ the King* (Fortress Press, 2009) as well as articles in *The Christian Century*, *Feasting on the Word*, *Feasting on the Gospels*, *Lutheran Forum*, *Word and World*, and Odyssey Network’s *ON Scripture*. Her blog on Passion Sunday for *The Christian Century* was one of the top ten blogs of 2011. Her current project is the fourth volume in the Fortress Press Biblical Preaching Commentary Series on the Gospel of John to be published in 2014. She is a contributing writer for www.workingpreacher.org and co-host of the site’s weekly podcast, *Sermon Brainwave*.
