

## Wechetowin – People Helping People

There is a group of RL people who have been answering a recurring call to pastoral ministry; they are known as Wechetowin.

First Peoples from northern and remote parts of Manitoba, Ontario and the Arctic are often in Winnipeg for medical and non-medical treatments and appointments. For many of these people the reason for their trip to Winnipeg is traumatic, AND, they have no-one in the city to comfort and care for them. Wechetowin is called by clergy and support workers to provide pastoral care and fellowship on their behalf.

There are now many stories of gratitude for the Wechetowin ministry, especially from families of those who were critical and chronic.

Wechetowin has existed since 2012 with no external funding; this is to say that Wechetowin members have been paying for their own communication and travel costs within the city to offer their excellent care.
